

Trustees Meeting

July 13, 2009

Attended By: Doc Miller, Bill Travis, Tricia Floyd, and Roger Beau

1. The June windstorm blew large limbs down from trees on the Parsonage property. Bill Travis, Roger Beau and neighborhood boys cut-up and removed the debris. The cut-off limb needs to be painted yet.
2. The June windstorm also blew off the roof hatch from the bell tower. The hatch once airborne put a large dent into the North roof, which is covered with tile appearing metal. Bill and Roger met with Mike Evans. Mike was able to reinstall the cover using his bucket truck. We installed eyebolts to the underneath side and secured the cover with ropes from the bottom inside. We don't yet have a roof repair estimate. Bill Travis checked the insurance, we have a \$1,000.00 deductible.
3. Roger Beau inquired with the city manager about sidewalk repairs at the church. He added our need to his list, commenting that the list is very long and will take a very long time to get to us.
4. Bill and Mary Hawk donated a 3' X 6' mirror for the library (Brides room) which was mounted by Bill and Roger. They also installed the mirror, which was replaced by the larger one in the library, outside the MYF (Grooms) room in the hallway.
5. Green Space: Doc Miller has been killing the weeds there.
6. Radon remediation has been done at the parsonage. Final testing has not been done yet.
7. Proposal for an inspection of the church stained glass was tabled.
8. Ceiling tile in the 2nd floor resource room needs to be replaced. Bill will check with McDowell's.

9. Doc Miller purchased and placed a replacement dehumidifier for the church basement. Cost \$200.00+
10. As of June 30th \$1,335 left in trustee's budget.
